Unification. Lincolnshire will be making a decision on the make up of the councils that represent you. I'm no supporter of the current council structure and would support proposals that genuinely improve efficiency and increase local representation but I will oppose unification proposals that reduce local representation, cut the quality of our services and waste our money.



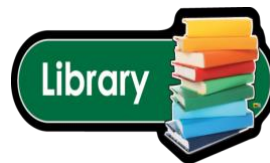
Potholes. The state of our roads is a disgrace. Our roads are not fit for purpose. And the county council, having received more funds for road repairs, extended the acceptable repair time from 30 to 90 days! And then, when the potholes are eventually repaired, they are repaired so badly the majority reappear in the next frost. This is a waste of taxpayers' money and the County Council has to do better, has to stop giving excuses for its failure to repair the roads, and I will work to improve the standard and safety of our roads.

Fly tipping. A modern blight on our beautiful countryside not helped by the county council closing local recycling centres and adopting restrictive practices. Yes, we need stronger enforcement; but we also need better and less restrictive policies to encourage people to dispose of their waste responsibly.

Speed limits. All our communities are suffering from speed limits that put the interests of motorists first and fail to address the needs of the community. Government recommends that where there are houses continuously on one or both sides of the road for 600m the speed limit should be 30. And yet the conservative controlled County Council continue to support speed limits of 40 and 50 mph in built up areas. I will work with community groups to get 30 mph speed limits in all our communities.



Environment and climate change is the big challenge for our time. We need better designed, better insulated housing with low carbon heating; cycle routes and public transport as an alternative to the car; renewable energy from solar but I will not support commercial wind turbines until we have exhausted all the zero carbon alternatives.



Services. We've seen the decimation of services in our communities. The closure of libraries being just one example. I'm very proud to have been instrumental along with our brilliant co-ordinator and volunteers to save the library in Branston. But in truth we should never have had to save the library in the first place. I will support funding for our schools, libraries, galleries, community assets.

Policing. We need properly resourced community policing. Please vote David Williams for Police and Crime Commissioner
